**October Maintenance Notes:**



**Dishwasher and Garbage Disposals**  
 Be sure to run your dishwasher once a month. It will help keep any musty smells away. If you do use your dishwasher, it's always a good idea to not overload it and only use dishwasher detergent recommended for automatic dishwashers. Always turn on the water when you are running the garbage disposal. If it's smelling bad, you can buy garbage disposal "breath mints" at the store. Or even easier, put a lemon or lime wedge in there and run it. It will help clean the blades and make it smell citrusy!

**Carpets and Flooring**  
 This is no doubt a no-brainer, but vacuum frequently. Ground-in dirt can ruin your carpeting. It's best to not shampoo your carpet yourself, check with the management team about cleaning options.

**Pest Control**  
 If you find you have a pest problem, please contact the management team, so service can be scheduled.
