Well it's that time of year when we keep a close eye on the tropics. If it becomes necessary for us to evacuate, be prepared with the four Ps!

- 1-Prescriptions-Have all your prescriptions gathered together. If you have them new prescriptions and doctors' orders make sure you bring them also.
- 2-Paperwork-This includes deeds, information on retirement accounts, Medicaid cards, Tricare cards and titles to cars and insurance cards.
- 3-Provisions-Make sure you bring bottled water and snacks in case store are not open when you arrive at your destination.
- 4-Provide AFEV information as to where you are going and emergency contact numbers. This allows us to keep you up to date on the status of AFEV. We want you back as soon as possible and I know you will be glad to be home.



The Satellite pharmacy has changed the BHV Transportation prescription pick up procedures. BHV Transportation will pick up BHV resident prescriptions on Mondays,

Wednesdays and Fridays. BHV Transportation will still be able to pick up prescriptions from the main pharmacy or an outside pharmacy Monday through Friday. In case of emergency, outside of normal pick up days, please contact the front desk.
