# Maintenance Notes & Updates

**Dumpster Info:** Dumpster doors need to stay open during the day light hours. The guards will open them and leave open in the day light. **PLEASE DO NOT** close the doors during day light hours. The guards will close them.

**Recycle Dumpster:** The recycle dumpster behind the Commons building is for Cardboard Only! Please no trash in there!!

As you can see, the Village 6 construction is underway. So, there will be plenty of extra traffic including tractor trailers using the road on the southside of 1100/1110 garages. Maintenance will be posting “No Parking” signs very soon. This is to protect the residents and vehicles.

Also, we are seeing an uptick in broken knobs and door locks on the washers and dryers. If the washer is in “wash” mode, please do not try to force the door open, after awhile the locking mechanism breaks. Furthermore, the knobs should only be turned hard enough to start the dryer.
