# Maintenance Notes & Updates

Village 2 Roof Replacement will begin sometime in March. Southeast Contractors are finishing up a few other commitments. As the start date gets closer, I will have a better scheduling timeline to keep you up-to-date. I do want to say upfront, it will be noisy during the re-roofing (a lot of nails) but please be patient and understanding.

POOL/SPA Update: As stated in the Resident’s Council meeting, we are awaiting Okaloosa Gas to run a bigger gas line to support both the spa and NEW pool heaters. In addition, as of 20 Feb the spa is a 1-2 weeks out from being resurface by Panhandle Pools. I know that it has been a long time coming, but I promise it will be worth the wait.

Lastly, Spring is coming. Please remember to keep your thermostat on “Auto”. This will help keep the humidity out of the apartments.
